The Commission's correspondence of September 8, 2021 noted that several of the VHF channels specified in this STA application were public safety channels, and that grant of those channels that were public safety channels required coordination from a public safety coordinator.

The applicant, MRTC, retained APCO International's Frequency Coordinator to examine these channels. The application has been amended to include the results and conclusions of the coordinator.

The coordinator ascertained that several of the channels were not valid public safety channels and could not be coordinated as such. The remaining channels were found to be clear, other than the frequency 154.025 MHz, which is in use in Indianapolis and therefore unavailable. That channel has been deleted from the pending STA application.

Therefore, as amended, the pending STA application can be granted and we would request such, prior to the proposed start date of October 15, 2021.
