
Dear 1 Harborside Dr,

This refers to application, File No. 0327-EX-PL-2016, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. The L-Band is being considered for auction, but at a minimum, studies are being done to see if all of the governments existing use can be compressed into a smaller portion of the band and there is no room in the band for another L-Band radar. For NTIA to support the deployment of a new radar system in the L-Band would undermine the efforts of various other government agencies who are looking at moving their operations to a small segment of the existing L-Band.
