Thank you for the frequency coordination request. The panel has discussed the application for satellite frequency coordination and has coordinated a frequency. We have however a concern that the mission, although interesting, has very little to do with amateur radio and should not really operate under an amateur license. Have you discussed this with the FCC?

We are also wondering if you have considered including an amateur type operation in your project.

Should you be able to go ahead with the project the frequency we have coordinated is 437,200 MHz.

You have indicated a launch date of July 2013 please advise us of final date for the launch when this becomes available and also what other satellites using amateur frequencies are on the same launch

Please note that all frequencies in the amateur satellite service are shared frequencies. We have attempted to make the best possible selection for your project.

You are also referred to the ITU requirements for satellites. We have prepared an easy reference document which is available on [www.iaru.org/satellite](http://www.iaru.org/satellite), it will assist you to comply with the ITU requirements for Amateur satellites.
