

**Supplemental Statement to Application for Special Temporary Authority
April 11, 2013**

Microsoft Corp. (“Microsoft”) submits this supplemental statement to clarify that the 20 frequencies specified in the main form for the above-referenced application are those on which the unintentional radiator prototype device may exceed the radiated emission limits for Class B unintentional radiators. Microsoft does not seek authority to exceed radiated emission limits for unintentional radiators on any other frequencies.

Moreover, by June 1, 2013, Microsoft intends to replace all units of the original prototype with modified prototype units that comply with the radiated emission limits for Class B unintentional radiators on all frequencies. Thereafter, all residential testing of the prototype device by Microsoft engineers and developers will be conducted using units that do not exceed Part 15 limits for radiated emissions.
