Message:

1. You have listed 1530 - 1559 MHz as a transmitting frequency, yet in your exhibit you say it is for receive-only by the mobile terminals. Unless that band is being used to transmit by something that you don't already have authorization for, it should be removed.
2. Please list all power and emission combinations in the technical data, not just in the exhibits. It must be made clear exactly what is being requested.
3. Please provide antenna data, such as beamwidth, polarization, and other data such as required in a Part 25 request for authorization. This information is necessary for the International Bureau to perform analysis.
4. Each location should be listed as a separate antenna/transmitter location in the technical data. The above changes may be made using the "Amend Application" button on our electronic filing site. Use the "Antenna Data," "Freq Data" and "Attachments" buttons, as appropriate.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of April 11, 2002 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
