REQUEST FOR NAME CHANGE

This is to respectfully request a change in the corporate name of the licensee from "Motorola, Inc." to "**Motorola Solutions, Inc.**"

Motorola Solutions, Inc. ("MSI"), applied for the license associated with this application under the corporate name "Motorola, Inc." On January 4, 2011, Motorola, Inc., changed its name to "Motorola Solutions, Inc." in connection with the restructuring of the company. It notified the Commission of the name change on January 27, 2011. See Letter from Kurt E. Re: **Notification of Administrative Change in Licensee Name**

To the Experimental Licensing Branch:

This is to notify the Commission of the change in the corporate name of Motorola, Inc., which holds the experimental radio authorizations listed in the attachment, and to request that the Commission's records be updated to reflect the change.

On January 4, 2011, Motorola, Inc., was restructured into two independent, publicly-traded companies.¹ As a result of the restructuring, Motorola, Inc., changed its corporate name to "**Motorola Solutions, Inc.**," reflecting only an administrative change in the name rather than a change in ownership. Motorola Solutions will remain responsible for Motorola's business activities addressing the communications requirements of the public safety and enterprise communities.
