Please confirm that FirstNet is the appropriate coordinator for the frequencies 769.05625 MHz, 769.06875 MHz, and 774.99375 MHz.

According to the [FCC list of Public Safety Frequency Coordinators](#), I would expect APCO to be the appropriate coordinator. These frequencies are in the narrowband Public Safety spectrum of 47 CFR 90.531 (b)(4), not in the Band Class 14 used by FirstNet.

Perhaps since these frequencies are itinerant nationwide, FirstNet is the coordinator ?
