Mr. Lewis,

The narrowbanding rules prohibit any request to operate above 12.5 kHz bandwidth, regardless of the proposed locations, operations or any other technical parameters. So please go ahead and adjust the bandwidth to 12.5 kHz or we'll have to remove the entire 406.1-420 MHz from processing.

Furthermore, any operations in military exclusive bands (225-328.6 MHz and 335.4-399.9 MHz) require an active/valid military contract. It appears you don't have one. That being the case, the Military Assignment Group (MAG) has agreed to consider your request only if you can select 2-3 center frequencies (i.e. 228 MHz, 375 MHz, etc.). Please select 2-3 center/spot frequencies within MAG bands and update your application.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of November 07, 2019 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
