Mr. Huie,

Per your request, I researched why the NFL Frequency Organization Group filed our STA request, file number 0496-EX-ST-2003, under Part 5 (Experimental Radio Service) of the FCC's rules instead of using Subpart A (Experimental Broadcast Stations) of Part 74.

While we are confining our operations to frequencies allocated to Parts 73 and 74, 74.101 defines an Experimental Broadcast Station as "... a station licensed for ... telecommunication services intended for reception and use by the general public". The operations we are proposing are not intended for reception by the general public, so we applied for the STA under Part 5 of the rules.
