As described below, NASC agrees to restrict operations to 400 AGL or below while using the ISM bands 902-938 MHz and 2400-2500 MHz for C2. NASC will coordinate with FAA to determine what bands are approved by them. As of 4 June 2019 (FAA/AUVSI Symposium in Baltimore) they had not made any decisions and did not seem motivated to do so!
