Omnipoint Technologies, Inc. ("OTI") hereby requests renewal of its Special Temporary Authority ("STA") originally granted under call sign KS2XAO, file number S-3054-EX-97.

OTI desires to continue operation of fully approved (type accepted) GSM-1900 and IS-661 equipment in and around Colorado Springs, Colorado for an additional six month period. Operation of this equipment is necessary to identify, evaluate and resolve interference problems between standard GSM and IS-661 equipment, the latter developed by OTI, when operated in the same geographic area. OTI's agreement with the F-band license holder for Colorado Springs (Omnipoint Colorado Springs F License, LLC, held by Omnipoint Corporation, OTI's parent company) will permit OTI to operate in the F-band throughout the STA renewal period.
