Mr. Burtle:

The above 442 along with the Request to Expedite constitute our Request to reinstate Call Sign WE2XGJ.

The UHF testing at Chilocco is in support of USSOCOM's PSYOP communication equipment test and evaluation requirements which support immediate overseas deployment to the theater of operations such as Afghanistan. These systems will be deployed in direct support of U.S. Special Operations and conventional forces. The use of PSYOP equipment is a key component of the Special Operations mission.

As you will see from the documentation already submitted, we allowed the WE2XGJ licenses to lapse under the assumption that all testing had been completed. However, the US SOCOM client has recently informed us of their need to retest in the UHF band, and hence the need for expedited review of the 0083-EX-PL-2010 application (Form 442).
