

Through a series of applications, Orbital ATK, Inc. (“Orbital ATK”), the parent company of the applicant, and Northrop Grumman Corporation (“Northrop Grumman”) have sought and received consent of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) in connection with a transaction pursuant to which Orbital ATK will be renamed and will become a wholly-owned subsidiary of Northrop Grumman. See, e.g., ULS File No. 0008019052 (consented to Feb. 5, 2018); IBFS File No. SAT-T/C-20180109-00006 (granted Feb. 15, 2018); ELS File No. 0007-EX-TU-2018 (granted Feb. 20, 2018). The parties requested in those applications that the FCC approvals received cover not only licenses currently held by Orbital ATK (or one of its wholly-owned subsidiaries), but also: (1) any FCC authorization granted to Orbital ATK (directly or indirectly) during the pendency of the subject transaction prior to closing; and (2) any application submitted by Orbital ATK (directly or indirectly), which is pending at the time the proposed transfer is consummated. Because the parties have not yet closed the transaction, this application is covered by the FCC approvals referenced in the sentence above.
