Panasonic Avionics Corporation ("Panasonic") hereby replies to the Commission's correspondence regarding prior coordination of operations in connection with its application to modify its experimental license, Call Sign WH2XCJ.

In response to the Commission's inquiry, Panasonic confirms that it has previously coordinated its operations in the 1427.9-1447.9 MHz, 1447.9-1462.9 MHz and 2300-2400 MHz bands with the Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council ("AFTRCC").

Panasonic does not seek to make any changes to its existing, previously coordination operations in the above frequency bands. This modification application only seeks to remove the 776-794 MHz band from the license, which overlaps with FirstNet frequencies from 788-798 MHz ("Band 14"). Panasonic seeks to replace the overlapping band with the 768-788 MHz band, where it will operate on a 1 MHz carrier at 785 MHz to avoid any overlap with Band 14.
