Chris,

As you know, on January 21, 2020, my client Sirius XM Radio Inc. (“Sirius XM”) submitted an informal objection to the above-referenced request by Persistent Systems, LLC (“Persistent Systems”) for experimental Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) based on concern that the proposed operations at a center frequency of 2310 MHz could cause harmful interference to subscribers’ reception of the Sirius XM signal in the 2320-2345 MHz band.

Persistent Systems subsequently amended its STA request to remove the 2310 MHz center frequency. This action rendered the Sirius XM concerns moot, and Sirius XM does not seek deferral of the STA request as amended or seek the imposition of conditions on any grant of the amended STA.

You may provide this email to the Federal Communications Commission as confirmation that the concerns raised in the Sirius XM informal objection have been resolved. Please let me know if you have any questions.
