Thank you for your e-mails facilitating our application for experimental license. As you can imagine, this process is new to me. With respect to pending application I have couple of questions in view of your e-mails.

- 1) We agree that it is not practical to have operation over the full band 2500 to 2655MHz, hence we would like block CD 2541.5 to 2561.5MHz and block HG 2663.5 to 2683.5 MHz provided that there are no present users in our immediate geographical area.
