This letter responds to Alta Wireless's September 18, 2014 letter relating to the Qualcomm Technologies Inc. Experimental License Application File No. 0628-EX-PL-2014.

Qualcomm notes as an initial matter that the FCC granted the application under Call Sign WH2XKA on September 23, 2014. Qualcomm will comply with the conditions on the grant including the prior coordination requirements set out in FCC Rule Section 101.103(d). *See* 47 C.F.R. § 101.103(d). Prior to commencing operations, Qualcomm will coordinate with Alta Wireless (licensed under Call Sign WPOH667) and its customer and spectrum lessee Nextlink Wireless, LLC (under Lease ID L000009808). Qualcomm plans to work with Comsearch for frequency coordination.

Qualcomm will take all reasonable precautions to ensure that no harmful interference is caused to any FCC licensees and will immediately cease its experimental operations in the event of harmful interference. Qualcomm will provide Alta Wireless and Nextlink Wireless a 24/7 "stop buzzer" contact phone number and email address that will instantly forward to multiple people at Qualcomm.
