To operate in the 1435-1525MHz and 2360 -2390MHz Telemetry Bands to provide Television coverage in Los Angeles, California.

RF Film, Inc. hereby requests Special Temporary Authority (STA) to operate in the 1435-1525MHz and 2360-2390MHz telemetry bands, pursuant to Section 21.25 of the Commission's Rules. RF Film, Inc. requests that the Commission grant it temporary authority to operate on the frequencies centered on 1444MHz, 2368MHz and 2382MHz with a 16MHz bandwidth from March 27, 2017 with intermittent usage and ceasing operation on March 28, 2017. As explained below, RF Film, Inc. is filing an STA request for the shooting of an episode of "Animal Kingdom" in and around Marina Del Rey, California. RF Film, Inc. submits that there are extraordinary circumstances warranting a grant of the STA request.

Horizon Scripted Television has contracted RF Film, Inc. to provide the necessary microwave for the shooting of this television show. Due to the extreme frequency congestion in the Los Angeles area, coupled with the added congestion from traditional Television and News coverage of special events in the area, RF Film requests the use of channels in the 1435-1525MHz and 2360-2390MHz Telemetry Bands.

RF Film, Inc. certifies that the operation of the requested channel for the purposes specified herein will not cause interference to any established stations.

Grant of the instant request for STA in the 1.4GHz and 2.3GHz bands would serve the public interest by enabling RF Film, Inc to supply the requested remote video coverage for this event. The proposed service would enhance filming of the event by providing on the spot pictures from mobile locations that would not otherwise be available to the production company. RF Film, Inc., is in the process of obtaining the consent of the relevant frequency coordinators for this project, including AFTRCC. AFTRCC has indicated its intent to forward the results of the coordination to the Commission.
