RF Film, Inc. hereby requests Special Temporary Authority (STA) to operate in the 1435-1525 MHz and the 2360 - 2390 MHz telemetry band, pursuant to Section 21.25 of the Commission's Rules. RF Film, Inc. requests that the Commission grant it temporary authority to operate on the frequency centered on **1476MHz and 2368MHz with a 16MHz bandwidth and 2384MHz with a 8MHz bandwidth** from September 20, 2017 with intermittent usage and ceasing operation on October 5, 2017. As explained below, RF Film, Inc. is filing an STA request for the shooting of "Cherry Blue" a Marvel feature film in San Francisco CA.. RF Film, Inc. submits that there are extraordinary circumstances warranting a grant of the STA request.

Marvel Productions, has contracted RF Film, Inc. to provide the necessary microwave for the shooting of this movie. Due to the extreme frequency congestion in the San Francisco area, coupled with the added congestion from traditional Television and News coverage of special events in the area, RF Film requests the use of 2 channels in the 2360-2390 MHz and 1 channel in the 1435 – 1525 MHz Telemetry Band.

RF Film, Inc. certifies that the operation of the requested channel for the purposes specified herein will not cause interference to any established stations.

Grant of the instant request for STA in the 2.3GHz and 1.4GHz band would serve the public interest by enabling RF Film, Inc. to supply the requested remote video coverage for this event. The proposed service would enhance filming of the event by providing on the spot pictures from mobile locations that would not otherwise be available to the production company. RF Film, Inc., is in the process of obtaining the consent of the relevant frequency coordinators for this project, including AFTRCC. AFTRCC has indicated its intent to forward the results of the coordination to the Commission.
