Raytheon respectfully requests confidential treatment of Exhibit 2 Description of Confidential Information submitted with this application ("Exhibit 2") pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act and the Commission's rules.0F1 As described below, this request meets the standards for confidential treatment:

1. Identification of the specific information for which confidential treatment is sought.

The specific information is contained in Exhibit 2.

2. Identification of the Commission proceeding in which the information was submitted or description of the circumstances giving rise to the submission.

FCC Form 442 request for modification of an existing license.

3. Explanation of the degree to which the information is commercial or financial, or contains a trade secret or is privileged.

Exhibit 2 contains confidential information that, if disclosed, would cause significant harm to Raytheon.
