Anne,

FirstNet has completed review of Raytheon license KA2XAG operating in the Tucson, AZ area and can accommodate the secondary use of 700 MHz Band 14 as described in the documents you provided. Please comply with the following special conditions:

1. Licensee to prior coordinate testing with other authorized Band 14 operations.
2. Licensee must accept interference from others operating in Band 14 and must not cause interference to FirstNet operations.
3. Licensee POC to submit a "Stop Buzzer" contact to FirstNet at peter.tomczak@firstnet.gov upon authorization issuance with "kill switch" authority; license POC agrees to immediately cease operations on Band 14 if notified of any interference concerns.
4. License subject to further review by the FCC and possible re-coordination with FirstNet.
