If you can notch out those frequency bands allocated under Parts 101 and 74F, please do so. Otherwise, address the following questions/comments:

1. The purpose and detailed prescriptions of the proposed operation.
2. Explanation of how it would coordinate any usage with the Upper Microwave Flexible Use Service (UMFUS) and Fixed Microwave Service licensees for the proposed operation.
3. An engineering analysis and explanation of how it would specifically avoid causing harmful interference to incumbent UMFUS and Fixed Microwave Service operations.
4. The most recent written agreements from the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator consenting to the use of the spectrum from 17.7 GHz to 19.7 GHz before a license can be issued.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of October 08, 2020 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
