Dear Sir,

Thanks for responding to our application. Our equipment is not certified CBSD and currently used for test and validation purposes in a software-defined fashion as described in Exhibit 1 of our application. As such, and with respect to item 1 of your requested additional information, we may not be able to register them into a SAS database. I should note that, we are in the development phase of a software-defined 5G-NR system as part of the RENEW project which requires us to perform over-the-air tests. At the end of the development phase (expected Q2 of 2023), the overall system can go through the CBSD certification process.

As for item 2, we have recently received authorization from Google to use the Google SAS as a test user. While this will not allow us to register any device there (not intended as described earlier), it allows us to get to know the activities of the incumbents and GAA users in the area. We plan to include SAS access into our software-defined solution and get notified of any usage in the area.
