Dear Joshua Kirschenheiter,

This refers to application, File No. 0843-EX-ST-2018, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. NTIA objected to your operations for the following reasons:

1. Potential interference with DSRC systems supporting public safety in the 5850 - 5925 MHz band.
2. Potential interference with Radio Astronomy in the 4.990 - 5.000 GHz band.
3. Lack of documented positive controls to address ascent, descent, overall flight path near air routes, controls to prevent overflying restricted airspace, and avoid potentially sensitive DOD areas.
