Are any of the frequencies listed in the application used for uplink? The location information is confusing to me because the mobile areas of operations all say "Low Earth Orbit," yet two of the frequencies list coordinates with a 500 km radius. Is something moving on the ground within 500 km of the coordinates listed? Which frequencies are uplink, downlink or both? If something is transmitting from the ground from a fixed location, then the radius should be zero.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of June 24, 2014 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
