Message:

1. Does the satellite have a camera on board? If so, submit a statement stating that applicant has a remote sensing license from NOAA.
2. The FCC's International Bureau (IB) says that the SpaceCap filing is defective. It is missing the location of the ground station along with the operational parameters that will communicate with the satellite. Resubmit a corrected SpaceCap document.
3. IB also notes that IARU requested confirmation of the name and full contact details of the person who will control the operation of SporeSat after launch. Was that information provided? If so, provide that information here.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of November 19, 2013 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
