Upon further Commission legal review, we have decided that there is no mechanism to handle "For Official Use Only (FOUO)" requests within the Experimental Licensing System. Also, under no circumstances can we withhold information related to the location of the transmitter or the frequencies being used, as this information is necessary for investigation of interference. The applicant is advised to select between one of the two following options: 1) Request removal of all exhibits that mention FOUO and replace them with exhibits that do not mention the FOUO classification of any data within the application; 2) Request withdrawal of the application and have the government sponsor file a licensing request through the Federal government process at NTIA.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of January 17, 2014 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
