1. You have asked for a period of operation of two years. If you really intend on operating longer than six months, you will need to refile on Form 442 using the New License/Modification of License link on our filing site.
2. You have asked for confidentiality of the entire application. We will not allow parameters that are necessary for interference mitigation, such as frequency, power and location, to be withheld from public inspection. If there is anything that you do require to be withheld from public inspection, you must separate it out from all other material in an exhibit and submit an item-by-item justification for the confidentiality request to answer the nine subsections of Part 0.459(b) of the FCC's rules. The justification and all non-confidential material must be viewable by the public.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of October 15, 2012 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
