

REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. (“Sirius”) hereby requests expedited treatment of its application for Experimental STA so that it may commence its experimental operations as soon as possible and not later than January 4, 2008. As discussed in the accompanying “Narrative Statement,” Sirius has a significant interest in the outcome of the Second Notice of Proposed Rulemaking and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (“NPRM”) regarding satellite radio terrestrial repeaters and Wireless Communications Services (WCS) operations.¹ Sirius’ objective in requesting this experimental STA is to be able to offer information regarding the results of its testing to the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) during the initial notice and comment period following publication of the NPRM in the Federal Register. To do so, Sirius needs to undertake these experiments as soon as possible so that it will have sufficient time to review the results and provide the Commission with data, analyses and conclusions that will be helpful in establishing the rules for satellite radio repeaters and WCS operations. The Commission has adopted a 30 day deadline following Federal Register publication for the filing of comments and, therefore, time is of the essence.

Accordingly, Sirius respectfully requests expedited treatment of its application for experimental special temporary authority so that it may commence the experimentation as soon as possible. Sirius submits that expedited processing of its request for an experimental STA is in the public interest, convenience, and necessity, as it will permit Sirius to provide the Commission with data that is essential to the Commission’s decisionmaking process.
