

The Office of Engineering and Technology approved the above-referenced applications for consent to the transfer of *de jure* control of Sirius XM Radio Inc. (“Sirius”) to Liberty Media Corporation (“Liberty Media”) on January 4, 2013. This is to notify the Commission that Liberty Media has consummated such transfer of *de jure* control. On January 18, 2013, Liberty Media converted its remaining Sirius B-1 Preferred Shares such that it owns approximately 50.21%¹ of the Sirius common stock deemed outstanding as of such date.

¹ This reflects the current record ownership of Sirius common stock by Liberty Media and its wholly owned subsidiaries. Liberty Media’s beneficial ownership interest as reported in a Schedule 13D Liberty Media filed today with the Securities and Exchange Commission is 50.25%, which reflects beneficial ownership of shares of Sirius Common Stock underlying certain exchangeable notes of Sirius held by Liberty Media.
