You have used 100 feet as your distance in your calculations. The calculations are supposed to show that the value is below -140 dBm 100 feet from the outside of the building, so you are entitled to add whatever distance your device is from the nearest outside wall to 100 feet. You can still use 100 feet in your calculations to simplify, but you have entered 39.8 pW into the form. This is the allowed value for 100 feet in EIRP. The Experimental Licensing System uses ERP. The allowed 100-foot value in ERP is 25 pW. Either change the value in the form or redo the calculations.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of January 26, 2016 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
