I have received your latest email regarding when you can expect to receive all of the completed documents for the RADSat application. All of the documents are accounted for and are being filled out, or have been submitted. These documents are: the NTIA space record data form (submitted), the Description of Research project (submitted), SpaceCap publication (in progress), and the Orbital Debris Assessment (in progress).
