We are making significant progress with the SpaceCap file and the ODAR. We recently finalized a frequency change and I updated our application accordingly. The ODAR is nearly ready to be uploaded to our application. At our team lead meeting this week, I will stress the importance of uploading the document as soon as possible. It needs to be reviewed, signed, and scanned. If all goes well, hopefully it can be uploaded by the end of next week. I will let you know if there is any delay.

I have found the SpaceCap software to be quite difficult to work with, as it is not user-friendly and requests information that we did not come across while creating our link budget. However, I understand it is an essential component of the application. I am looking for more documentation on how to navigate the software. Furthermore, I have requested clarification from the International Bureau on the fee schedule. I do not want to submit the file and then have to pay when funds are not readily available.
