a) The narrative in one of the supporting documents that comes with the STA stating, "Grant of the LEMUR-2 Satellite STA request will allow KeyW to provide valuable demonstration and test data to the United States Air Force in a timely manner." Provide the United States Air Force POC info for this project/effort.

KeyW Corp. ("KeyW") provided the United States Air Force POC information in its confidential exhibit in ELS File No. 1403-EX-ST-2019 on July 31, 2019. Spire incorporates by reference both the exhibit and associated request for confidential treatment.

b) For the 2200-2290 MHz band: Spire Global, Inc requests to operate the entire 2200-2290 MHz band with only 1M00G1D emission bandwidth. Provide a specific fixed frequency within the 2200-2290 MHz band that you want to operate. It is not practical to analyze for a band assignment.

Spire will only operate at 2200-2201 MHz.

c) For the 8025-8400 MHz band: Spire Global, Inc requests to operate the entire 8025-8400 MHz band with only 60M0G1D emission bandwidth. Provide a specific fixed frequency within the 8025-8400 MHz band that you want to operate. It is not practical to analyze for a band assignment.

Spire will only operate at 8170-8230 MHz.
