Request for Modification of Condition 10

Experimental license WE2XEZ currently has eleven special conditions for use of GPS re-radiation. Textron Systems Corporation sees obvious merit in these conditions and has been diligent to ensure each of them is followed to the letter. There is, however, one small portion of condition 10 that, with a slight modification, would increase the savings we derive from these devices. Condition 10 reads as follows:

“(10) This authorization is issued for the **express** purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the U.S. Government contract number W15QKN-08-C-0448, W15QKN-06-C-0161 and 3EC1727/SEC8415. **The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized.** Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.”

Our interpretation of the portions in highlight prevents us from testing GPS receivers on products being developed in the same facility locations as the products under contract, only because they have not yet been purchased by the government. This restriction adds additional time and expense in order to relocate developmental products outside for testing GPS reception when they are already in an area that is receiving an authorized GPS re-radiated signal.

We respectfully request that the FCC consider a modification of the language in condition 10 that will allow us to test the developmental products not covered by the government contract numbers using the re-radiated GPS signals authorized for supporting the government contracts.
