ASRI concurrence is contingent upon the following:

- **SHALL NOT BE** Able to claim protection from, nor interfere with, other VDLM2 frequencies used for live AOC/ATC traffic.
- **SHALL NOT BE** Used for live operational/ATC traffic or integrated into a private operational VDLM2 MF network.
- **SHALL NOT BE** Guaranteed any level of performance within the RF environment, it is for the functional testing of VDLM2 message traffic only.
- **SHALL NOT BE** Used for operational aircraft, the ground station operator must exercise access control so that only test aircraft or avionics rigs can access the channel (e.g. whitelist, etc.).
- **SHALL NOT BE** Used for POA traffic, only VDL ATN/AOA message testing allowed.
- **SHALL NOT BE** Kept in the aircraft CMU lookup table once aircraft has completed certification and testing.

If interference is received by any ASRI user, Boeing must cease operations upon the request of ASRI immediately.
