- 1- You didn't fill out state and city information on the transmitter part of your application. Please complete it.
- 2- You submitted the FAA coordination with NG T number, but it is only ONE approved frequency 1370 MHz not the whole band as you filled out on the experimental application. Please contact with FAA coordinator to make correction.
- 3- For AFTRCC coordination, if you don't want to coordinate with AFTRCC or you don't have AFTRCC numbers, you should exclude 1435 MHz, 2360 MHz and 2395 MHz on the application because these frequencies are adjacent to Aeronautical Mobile Telemetry (AMT) allocations. It is required by AFTRCC.
