
Dear Professor Belz:

I am writing in response to your questions regarding installation of an eighty-four foot tall tower and fence in the field north of 670 West Main in Delta, Utah. It is my understanding that this tower will be used to support transmitting antennas as part of your effort to detect cosmic rays using radar. The fence will prevent public access to the tower.

Inasmuch as this tower and antenna will be located on property leased by the University of Utah from Quality Oil, there are no obstacles to construction provided the entire installation, including fencing, is located a minimum of twenty feet from the property line, in accordance with the Highway Commercial Zone. You are also permitted to have a conduit pushed underneath the surface of the city-maintained paved road forming the east boundary of the field, in order to connect your mast to the Millard County Cosmic Ray Center located at 648 West Main Street.
