

Description of Coordination with SAS and GAA Incumbents

In keeping with the Commission's rules on the use of the Citizens Broadband Radio Service (CBRS) 3550-3700 MHz band (3.5 GHz band), Viasat will work with CommSearch to determine usage by Incumbent operators including General Authorized Access (GAA) as well as Spectrum Access System (SAS) users. Once we have that information, we will coordinate with the authorized users of the band prior to operation of the link within these specific frequencies understanding the rules as summarized below.

Incumbent Access users include authorized federal users in the 3550-3700 MHz band, Fixed Satellite Service (space-to-Earth) earth stations in the 3600-3650 MHz band, and grandfathered wireless broadband licensees in the 3650-3700 MHz band. Additionally, GAA users can operate throughout the 3550-3700 MHz band, but must not cause harmful interference to Incumbent Access users or Priority Access Licensees and must accept interference from these users.
