The application is dismissed because NTIA objects to the FCC STA request on behalf of Virgin Orbit, LLC for Mojave, CA during the period 1 August 2018 thru 31 January 2019, for the following reason(s):

- 1. HIA indicated for multiple frequencies and bandwidths.
- 2. Launch vehicles should restrict emission bandwidths to 5 MHz or less.
- 3. Launch vehicles should utilize the four frequencies given in the draft NPRM on commercial launch (i.e., 2211.0 ± 4 MHz, 2215.0 ± 4 MHz, 2272.5 ± 2 MHz, and 2285-2290 MHz.
