REQUEST FOR RENEWAL

WIRELESS TECHNOLOGY, INCORPORATED respectfully requests an extension of the operations permitted under Experimental Radio Service Station License KA2XXX, File Number 5089-EX-R-98, expiring February 1, 2000.

The Special Condition (3) issued for the first time during the current February 1, 1998 through February 1, 2000 period regrettably was misread, inadvertently, as not different from the previous authorization document, and missing the new requirement, a first-year PROGRESS REPORT was not completed. Therefore, respectfully, WIRELESS TECHNOLOGY, INCORPORATED requests a Waiver of a separate first year's Report in favor of the full-term Report presented herewith.

This is to confirm that, in accordance with Experimental Radio Service Station License KA2XXX, File Number 5089-EX-R-98, Special Condition (3), during the license term expiring February 1, 2000 WIRELESS TECHNOLOGY, INCORPORATED has continued to conduct equipment testing, product development, and equipment demonstrations in the authorized 2450-2483.5 MHz frequency band pursuant to Part 5, Sections 5.3(g), (i) and (d) [47 CFR Part 5, §§5.3(g), (i), (d)], respectively. For the full license period, such operations were conducted in accordance with the needs of station licensing eligibles under FCC Rule Part 90, Sections 90.20(a) "Public Safety Pool" and 90.35(a), "Industrial/Business Pool" [47 CFR Part 90, §§90.20(a) and 90.35(a)] and under FCC Rule Part 101, Section 101.601 "Operational Fixed Service" [47 CFR Part 101, §101.601]. Although regular licensing continues under Part 101, station licensing has been restricted under Part 90. Still, such Part 90 station licensing, under specific waiver, is possible and it is requested that it not be eliminated from the terms of renewal of the Experimental License KA2XXX authorization. During the most recent period, at times, up to the authorized maximum bandwidth and power limitations were employed, and such continuing operational flexibility will be needed, where authorized, for the new license period.
