This frequency request corresponds to two assignments (NG 128977 and NG 128998/FRB: 510-515KHz/FLN: 0208-EX-RR-2012) that are already in the GMF with expiration date 10/21/2017. The frequency band can be extended to 517 KHz and that will not cause any impact to the FAA. The FCC can submit a modification request of the existing licenses to reflect their proposed FRB (510-517 KHz).

No FAA coordination is required for 130-190 KHz.
