1) The application appears to be focused on the applicability of the technology to future operations under Part 96. Since that rule part only covers the 3550-3700 MHz band, why does the application needs to test in the 3300-3550 MHz and 3700-3800 MHz bands?

2) How will the application avoids causing interference to existing users, including FSS earths stations, in the 3700-3800 MHz band?

In response to each of the questions:

There was an error in the original application. We used our application for a previous trial as a template for this trial and we failed to remove 3300 &ndash; 3550 MHz and 3700 &ndash; 3800 MHz bands from the application for spectrum to be used for this trial. The only spectrum to be used for this trial is in the Part 96 covered 3550 &ndash; 3700 MHz spectrum.
