<u>Inquiry 1</u>. On April 10, 2020, the FCC's Office of Engineering and Technology sent an inquiry to the applicant on behalf of the International Bureau:

Respond to the comments below from the FCC's International Bureau: For operations in the 2483.5-2500 MHz band, applicant must obtain a written consent from Globalstar Licensee LLC

Response 1. World View is working on securing the proper written consent, and it will provide that information to the FCC once it is available.

<u>Inquiry 2</u>. On April 14, 2020, the FCC's Office of Engineering and Technology sent an inquiry to the applicant asking if there was a federal customer for the proposed experimentation. There was also a cautionary note about congestion in the 2200-2290 MHz band.

Response 2. World View does not have a federal customer for this testing. Therefore, we are unable to provide federal customer contact information. This testing is for independent research and development.

<u>Inquiry 3</u>. On April 15, 2020, the FCC's Office of Engineering and Technology sent an inquiry to the application requesting that the Applicant remove the 2200-2290 MHz band from its application.
