On January 7, 2000, XM Radio Inc., the holder of a license to launch and operate a Digital Audio Radio Service (DARS) system, filed a request for an experimental STA pursuant to Section 5.61 of the Commission's Rules to test terrestrial repeater transmitters at four fixed locations around the Ft.
