Good afternoon Nimesh,

Thank you for your timely email re STA 1012-EX-ST-2019. To answer your questions directly:

Q1. Do you have the pre-coordination letter from all three agencies below?

A1: We did not receive a pre-coordination letter from the three agencies listed in the STA Dismissal Letter (USAF, USN, NASA) and were unaware of the requirement to receive them. We only received the STA Dismissal letter you have referenced for STA 0577-EX-ST-2019).

Q2: In your prior STA Dismissal letter, there is note that says if XTAR LLC wishes to submit future requests, NTIA requests pre-coordination be accomplished with the following agencies via the POC's given US Air Force. POC Jimmy Nguyen, Email: Jimmy.nguyen@us.af.mil; US Navy. POC Darren Townsend. Email: darrentownsend@navy.mil, NASA: POC Bryan Rhodes. Email: bryan.a.rhodes@nasa.gov.

A2: After receiving the STA Dismissal letter (STA 0577-EX-ST-2019), we met with key representatives from Army, Navy, and Air Force SMOs on 5 June at HQDISA to explain the original licensing effort, and provided them a hardcopy of the new STA request package (1012-EX-ST-2019). Having explained our intent, we were told that a new pre-coordination for this same effort would not be required.

Greatly appreciate your email, Nimesh, and I am adding ARSTRAT, Navy, and Air Force program offices that have been closely following this truly-joint handoff testing effort since the XTAR STA/license request first began on 4 April 2019 with the submission of STA 0577-EX-ST-2019. As we are trying to support WGS-XTAR handoff testing now beginning the week of 5 August, it may be prudent to keep all service reps, including ARSTRAT, Navy, and Air Force, involved from here forward to help prevent any further delays.
