

ARINC CONFIDENTIAL REQUEST 2

(1) Identification of the specific information for which confidential treatment is sought;

ARINC is requesting that the attachments that describe the specific nature of the ARINC STA request be made confidential.

(2) Identification of the Commission proceeding in which the information was submitted or a description of the circumstances giving rise to the submission;

FCC file # 0391-EX-ST-2001.

(3) Explanation of the degree to which the information is commercial or financial, or contains a trade secret or is privileged;

There is no commercial, financial or trade secret involved with our request.

(4) Explanation of the degree to which the information concerns a service that is subject to competition;

Competition is not a factor in regards to the information that we have provided. Our request is to merely respond to a Federal law enforcement request to enhance safety abroad aircraft.

(5) Explanation of how disclosure of the information could result in substantial competitive harm;

No competitive harm would come to ARINC if the information were to be made public.

(6) Identification of any measures taken by the submitting party to prevent unauthorized disclosure;

ARINC's request for confidentiality of the actual filing on the FCC website.

(7) Identification of whether the information is available to the public and the extent of any previous disclosure of the information to third parties;

ARINC and Federal law enforcement officials are aware of the request to provide aircraft with the added ACARS datalink safety measure. ARINC Frequency Management is not aware of other parties that might have this information.

(8) Justification of the period during which the submitting party asserts that material should not be available for public disclosure; and

ARINC has requested an STA for 6 months. No testing will be conducted beyond this time period.

(9) Any other information that the party seeking confidential treatment believes may be useful in assessing whether its request for confidentiality should be granted.
