Thank you for your note inquiring of the purpose of the new application as Experimental License WJ2XUP, which expires December 1, 2020, contains authority for the AeroVironment labs at Simi Valley and Moorpark, CA to access 454.7-454.975 MHz and 459.7-459.975 MHz.

With the high altitude testing moved to Spaceport America, New Mexico and that the license holder of the underlying segment leased the band to Aero Systems OpCo, LLC, the segment AeroVironment is accessing was adjusted to 454.675-454.975 MHz and 459.675-459.975 for operational purposes. We secured the concurrence of the leaseholder to access the band at Spaceport America and the AeroVironment's labs. It is for this reason we filed a separate application for the laboratory testing as it reflects the slightly adjusted band, the concurrence of the leaseholder and that lab testing will continue beyond the expiration of WJ2XUP. If the Commission prefers, we will instead file a modification to WJ2XUP.
