Aethero Space, Inc. (“Aethero”) hereby submits this letter in response to your questions received on May 14, 2026.

Regarding the earth station in Deadhorse, AK, Aethero expects its earth station partner RBC Signals to submit an application for the requested uplink channels.

Titan’s nominal mission length is two years but its satellite bus is designed to have a lifetime of five years or more. Aethero does not anticipate the Titan mission lasting longer than two years but wanted to alert the Commission ahead of time that under certain circumstances, Aethero may seek to extend the mission. Aethero’s expectation is that if Titan operates for longer than two years it would continue its mission as an experimental and demonstration satellite. There are no plans for Titan to provide a commercial service at any point during its mission.

Regarding the payloads onboard Titan, all payloads will be owned and operated by Aethero. Titan’s mission is strictly for experiment and demonstration purposes. To the extent that Aethero provides any remote sensing data to third parties, it will be for the purpose of demonstrating the capabilities of its onboard edge computer system to process remote sensing imagery on-orbit.

Aethero is grateful for the Commission’s speedy review of its application and has submitted the requested updates in the application’s Form 442 or as an exhibit to the application file. Please direct any questions or requests for further information to the undersigned.
