Attached please find an application on behalf of the Agusta Westland Philadelphia Corp seeking approval to add frequencies to experimental license, call sign WG2XRX.

Agusta Westland is seeking approval to operate on a variety of frequencies in order perform functional test (TX/RX) on specific frequencies to ensure their systems are working properly before an aircraft can be certified.

ASRI has been in contact with Mr. Howard Fine with the Society of Broadcast Engineers in an effort to prescreen some of the requested frequencies prior to submission with the FCC.

Mr. Fine has verified that frequencies 481.000 MHz and 520.000 MHz should not present a problem to existing users on these frequencies. For your information, we also sought concurrence to use frequencies 174.000 and 450.000 but those requests resulted in potential interference concerns.

Aviation Spectrum Resources Inc. (ASRI) has been asked to assist Agusta Westland to attempt to license these frequencies.
